**Stop Colonel Mark Toy & Straub Construction from continuing the use ground/surface water within our federally designated Sole Source Aquifer, despite County Stop Work Orders, for construction at new US Border Patrol Station in Boulevard, CA**

**INFORMATION PERTAINING TO THIS REQUEST** (Background. Use additional sheets if necessary; list enclosures if applicable.)

Despite intervention from San Diego County Supervisor Dianne Jacob, County Codes Enforcement, Congressman Hunter's office, requests from our elected land use advisory group, Boulevard Planning Group, requests from the Boulevard Border Patrol, and requests from numerous local residents, the use of this unauthorized water source, that places at risk those that rely on the very small Live Oak Springs district's less than stellar water management, Colonel Toy has refused to stop Straub Construction from continuing to purchase water from this legally unauthorized source.

The stated reason for allowing the unauthorized use reported to be concern over potential litigation over increased costs--and they only had two more weeks to go. However, that is no excuse to flout local authorities or to put the local community's water supply at risk. The vendor has a history of non-compliance including falsifying water quality reports. Our local community deserves to know that this affront will be stopped and not allowed on future projects under ACOE authority. All contractors should be required to provide documented evidence that water sources are purchased in a manner that is compliant with local regulation--especially in an area like ours that is semi-arid high desert with limited rainfall, no access to imported water, and federally designated as the Campo/Cottonwood Creek Sole Source Aquifer.
